## **ABOUT LADIES ROCK CAMP**

The Ladies Rock Camp (LRC) is a weekend day camp in NE Portland, OR that provides an opportunity for ladies 19 and over to let loose for the weekend and play rockin' music together. You'll start to learn and/or practice your instrument of choice\* on Friday, then keep receiving instrument instruction all weekend. Also, you'll form a band and work together to write an original song that you will play together on stage on Sunday. The Ladies Rock Camp Showcase is an unbelievable experience! In addition, you will have the opportunity to attend a variety of workshops with topics related to being a lady rocker. All proceeds from Ladies Rock Camp go directly to the Rock 'n' Roll Camp for Girls.

\*Choice of instruments includes Bass, Drums, Guitar, Vocals, and Keys.

## **ABOUT THE ROCK 'N' ROLL CAMP FOR GIRLS**

The Rock 'n' Roll Camp for Girls, a 501(c)3 non-profit, builds girls self-esteem through music creation and performance. Providing workshops and technical training, we create leadership opportunities, cultivate a supportive community of peers and mentors, and encourage social change and the development of life skills. We pursue this mission by offering programs throughout the year including the Girls Rock Institute and the RnRC4G Summer Camp. Each program, lesson and workshop uses music and topics related to music to teach both technical skills and life skills.

Any woman age 21 and over may apply. **NO MUSICAL EXPERIENCE NECESSARY.** You don't even have to bring your own instrument, but feel free if you like.

## **TUITION**

The cost of camp this year is \$390.00, regardless of whether you apply online or by mail. **FEES MUST BE INCLUDED WITH YOUR APPLICATION.** You can also make a secure online tuition payment through Auctionpay on our website at <http://www.girlsrockcamp.org/programs/applications-tuition>.

LRC's purpose is to generate funds and awareness for the Rock 'n' Roll Camp for Girls, as well as reach out to women who support our mission. Tuition has been set at the absolute lowest amount possible for us to cover our costs and meet expected financial goals for our programs. ## **CAPACITY**

Space is limited to 55 participants, first come, first served. Sessions fill up fast so get your application in early!

## **ENROLLMENT PROCESS AND CONFIRMATION**

We will confirm your enrollment via email, mail or telephone as soon as we process your application and check, and no later than May 1<sup>st</sup> for the May camp and October 1<sup>st</sup> for the October camp. If instrument spots fill up before your application and check reaches us, we will notify you by telephone, mail or email and automatically assign you to your second instrument choice. We will add you to a waiting list for your first instrument choice. If your preferred session of LRC is full, you can elect to have us either keep your check in the event of a cancellation, or, we will return or destroy your check. We will announce on our website when enrollment or specific instruments are full.

## **SWITCHING SESSIONS**

We understand that life happens and things come up that might prohibit you from attending the camp in which you are enrolled. If you need to switch sessions, you may do so at no cost, provided you give us at least 30 days notice prior to the start of camp. This will give us enough time to fill your space. However, if you decide to switch sessions 1-30 days before camp starts, you will be charged a \$50.00 fee.

## **CANCELLATION POLICY**

Should you need to cancel altogether and you give us at least 30 days notice prior to the start of camp, you will be issued a full refund, minus a \$50 application fee. However, if you cancel within 30 days of the start of camp, you will be charged an additional \$50.00 cancellation fee on top of the application fee. Please note that if you are enrolled in the October session and need to cancel, we can not roll over your application to a session in 2011. In this case, we will give you a refund and ask you to reapply if you want to attend a camp in 2011.

## **ACCOMMODATIONS**

The Rock Camp does not provide accommodations. There are several hotels nearby. Also, some local participants may be willing to host out-of-town campers. Please indicate your preference on the application. We highly recommend the following hotel as they have provided us good service and are within a mile of camp.

## **SCHEDULE**

About one month before camp, you will receive a detailed schedule of the weekend. However, you can plan on camp beginning at 11:30AM on Friday and ending around 5:00PM on Sunday, including Showcase times. Please take these hours into consideration when making travel arrangements and adjusting work schedules. It's a good idea to allow about two hours of travel and check in time to get to and from the airport by car, or 3 hours by public transportation, for your departing flight on Sunday. If you can, we recommend staying until Monday morning. There will be a celebration party after the Showcase on Sunday that is not to be missed!
