ABOUT LADIES ROCK CAMP

The Ladies Rock Camp (LRC) is a weekend day camp in NE Portland, OR that provides an opportunity for ladies 19 and over to let loose for the weekend and play rockin' music together. You'll start to learn and/or practice your instrument of choice* on Friday, then keep receiving instrument instruction all weekend. Also, you'll form a band and work together to write an original song that you will play together on stage on Sunday. The Ladies Rock Camp Showcase is an unbelievable experience for beginners and experienced musicians alike! In addition, you will have the opportunity to attend a variety of workshops with topics related to being a lady rocker. All proceeds from Ladies Rock Camp go directly to the Rock 'n' Roll Camp for Girls.

*Choice of instruments includes Bass, Drums, Guitar, Vocals, Keys, and DJ/Turntables.

ABOUT THE ROCK 'N' ROLL CAMP FOR GIRLS

Our mission is to encourage, engage and showcase the musical, artistic and individual talents of girls and young women ages 8-18, and empower them with tools for self-reliance as a means to enhance and affirm positive self-esteem. We pursue this mission by offering programs throughout the year including the Girls Rock Institute and the RnRC4G Summer Camp. Each program, lesson and workshop uses music and topics related to music to teach both technical skills and life skills.

The Rock 'n' Roll Camp for Girls is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. This means that all donations made to us (in-kind and monetary) are tax deductible, and much appreciated! The Rock 'n' Roll Camp for Girls has grown to become what it is today because of unending community support. WHO MAY APPLY FOR LADIES ROCK CAMP

Any woman age 19 and over may apply. **NO MUSICAL EXPERIENCE NECESSARY.** You don't even have to bring your own instrument, but feel free if you like.

TUITION

The cost of camp is \$375.00. **FEES MUST BE INCLUDED WITH YOUR APPLICATION.** Ladies Rock Camp can accept credit-card payments online. Just go to our website at www.girlsrockcamp.org and pay using Auction Pay. The application and payment deadline is March 15, 2009 for the May camp and August 31, 2009 for the October camp.

LRC is a fundraiser for the Rock 'n' Roll Camp for Girls. Tuition has been set at the absolute lowest amount possible for us to cover our costs and meet expected fundraising goals for our programs. Because we are a fundraiser, we will not be offering an early registration fee or reduced tuition option this year. If you can give more than the tuition, the Rock 'n' Roll Camp for Girls will enthusiastically accept your donation! Rock 'n' Roll Camp for Girls is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, which means that all donations are tax deductible. While your tuition is not considered a donation, any amount beyond that is so please consider giving an extra amount if at all possible. Whether you can give \$5.00 or \$5,000.00, every little bit helps and is greatly appreciated! Our federal tax ID # is 93-1321280.

ACCEPTANCE CONFIRMATION

We will confirm your acceptance via email, mail or telephone as soon as we receive your application and check and no later than April 1st for the May camp and September 10th for the October camp. If enrollment fills up before your application and check reaches us, we will notify you by telephone, mail or email and offer to put you on a wait list. At that time you may elect to have us either keep your check should you get in, or return or destroy your check. We will announce on our website when enrollment is full.

SWITCHING SESSIONS

We understand that life happens and things come up that might prohibit you from attending the camp in which you are enrolled. If you need to switch sessions, you may do so at no cost, provided you give at least 30 days notice prior to the start of camp. This will give us enough time to fill your space. However, if you decide to switch sessions within 30 days before camp starts, you will be charged a \$50.00 convenience fee.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Should you need to cancel altogether and you give us at least 30 days notice prior to the start of camp, you will be issued a full refund, minus a \$50 application fee. However, if you cancel within 30 days of the start of camp, you will be charged an additional \$50.00 convenience fee on top of the application fee. Please note that if you are enrolled in the October session and need to cancel, we cannot roll over your application to a session in 2010 for budget reasons. In this case, we will give you a refund and ask you to reapply if you want to attend a camp in 2010.

ACCOMMODATIONS

The Rock Camp does not provide accommodations. There are several hotels nearby. Also, some local participants may be willing to host out-of-towners. Please indicate your preference on the application. If you choose to stay in a hotel, the Rock Camp will provide one shuttle each morning and each evening from the hotel listed below.

SCHEDULE

About a month before camp, you will receive a detailed schedule of the weekend. However, you can plan on camp beginning at 11:30AM on Friday and ending around 5:00PM on Sunday, including showcase times. Please take these hours into consideration when making travel arrangements and adjusting work schedules. It's a good idea to allow about two hours buffer time to get to and from the airport and check in for your departing flight on Sunday. If you can, we recommend staying until Monday morning. There will be a celebration party after the showcase on Sunday that is not to be missed!
