Thank you for your interest in being an intern! The Rock 'n' Roll Camp for Girls strives to build a positive learning environment, resource center, and community for all ages of girls in music. The purpose of providing internship positions is to provide a place for older students to engage more fully in the mission of the Rock Camp. We look forward to working with you.

Position Overview: Girls Rock Institute Interns are learning by leading through shadowing an instrument instructor for a full term, or picking a specific skill associated with music as an area of focus. The year round internship position is open to 16-18 year old girls who have at least one year of GRI or two years of Summer Camp experience.

Duties:

- Attend each intern shift and end of term Showcase
- Check in with volunteer coordinator for daily chores and your mentor for that day's tasks
- Fulfill assignments and tasks as delegated by staff

Requirements: We are looking for candidates who are responsible, timely, self-directed, and problem solvers with leadership qualities tempered by an ability to understand and follow directions. Must also have good communication skills, and a love for the mission of the Rock 'n' Roll Camp for Girls. The following skills are useful, but not required:

- Ability to lift amps, drums, etc.
- Computer literacy (Macintosh, Microsoft Office Suite, Internet/email)
- Phone and writing competency
- Accuracy in fulfilling product orders via email, phone, etc
- Graphic design
- Illustration

Work Hours: Intern commitments are typically 3-5 hours weekly.

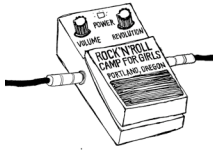
